

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








#### 2020 HPL Frequency per OBE

Overview of MPL Statutes:	
Statute of Limitations	Within 2 years after the cause of action accrues. Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. §12-542. Arizona case law generally supports the reasonable discovery rule for cause of action accrual. See Walk v. Ring, 202 Ariz. 310, 44 P.3d 990 (2002). SOL is tolled for plaintiff under 18 or of unsound mind until the removal of the disability. Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. §12-502.
Punitive damages	No statutory limit.
Joint and Several	Several Only. Each defendant liable only for the amount of damages allocated to that defendant, but exceptions apply when parties are acting in concert, or there is an agency relationship. Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. §12-2506.
Limits on contingent attorney fees	No statutory limit.
Periodic payment of future damages	Statute which allowed a party to elect to receive or pay future damages in periodic installments was ruled unconstitutional. Smith v. Myers, 181 Ariz. 11, 887 P.2d 541 (1994).
Apology laws	Statements or conduct expressing apology, responsibility or liability made to the patient or patient's relative are inadmissible as evidence of an admission of liability. Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. §12-2605.
Alternative dispute resolution	No statutory requirements specific to medical malpractice.
Collateral source rule	Defendant may introduce evidence of collateral payments, but plaintiff may then introduce evidence of amounts plaintiff paid to secure the right to such benefit. Bans subrogation. Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. §12-565.
Comparative fault	Pure Comparative Negligence. Claimant's awarded damages proportionately reduced by claimant's share of fault. Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. §12-2505.
Certificate of merit	If plaintiff certifies that expert testimony is necessary, plaintiff must serve a preliminary expert opinion affidavit with the initial disclosures. AZ Rules of Civil Procedure - Rule 26.1.
Expert witness	Expert must be licensed as a health professional in any state, and expert's training and experience must be similar to the health care provider. Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. §12-2604. Requirements for the necessary experience vary depending on type of provider involved. Id.
Nurse Practitioner scope of practice	NP's have full independent practice authority under the licensure authority of the State Board of Nursing. Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. §32-1601(20). An NP may prescribe and dispense drugs, including Schedules II-V controlled substances, within the NP's population focus. See Ariz. Admin. Code §4-19-511 and -512.
Physician Assistant scope of practice	PA may perform delegated tasks, including prescribing Schedules II through V controlled substances, that are within the PA's skills and the physician's scope of practice. Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. §32-2531 and -2532.
